

Legally Healthy Affiliate Program Terms & Conditions

Last Updated: Feb 2026

These Affiliate Program Terms & Conditions (“Terms”) govern participation in the Legally Healthy Affiliate Program (“Program”) operated by Chantel Ryan trading as Legally Healthy (ABN 83 648 734 350) (“Legally Healthy”, “we”, “us”, “our”).

By applying to or participating in the Program, you agree to be bound by these Terms.

1. Eligibility and Approval

1.1 Participation in the Program is subject to application and approval.

1.2 We reserve the right to approve or reject any affiliate application in our sole discretion.

1.3 We may suspend or remove an Affiliate from the Program at any time, with or without notice, including where we believe the Affiliate has breached these Terms or acted inconsistently with our brand values.

2. Nature of the Program

2.1 Approved Affiliates will receive:

- A unique affiliate tracking URL; and/or
- An approved 10% discount code (upon request and approval).

2.2 Discount codes must be requested by email to hello@legallyhealthy.com.au and approved by Legally Healthy prior to use. We reserve the right to approve, modify or reject any requested code.

2.3 Affiliates may promote Legally Healthy using only their approved affiliate link and/or approved discount code.

2.4 If both an affiliate link and discount code are used in a single transaction, only one commission will be payable.

3. Commission Structure

3.1 Affiliates are entitled to receive 20% commission on eligible sales made through their approved affiliate link or discount code.

3.2 Commission is calculated on the net sale amount actually received by Legally Healthy, excluding:

- GST;
- Refunds;
- Chargebacks;
- Payment processing fees; and
- Any other transaction reversals.

3.3 Commissions apply only to template products offered by Legally Healthy and do not apply to any excluded products or services.

3.4 Commission is only payable on completed transactions that are not refunded, reversed or subject to chargeback.

3.5 If a sale is refunded, reversed or subject to chargeback, the associated commission may be:

- Cancelled prior to payment; or
- Deducted from future commission payments.

4. Payment Terms

4.1 Affiliates must provide a valid PayPal email address via the affiliate dashboard in order to receive payment.

4.2 Commission payments are made on the 15th day of each month for eligible sales made in the preceding calendar month.

4.3 Legally Healthy is not responsible for failed payments due to incorrect PayPal details provided by the Affiliate.

4.4 Affiliates are responsible for their own tax obligations, including GST where applicable.

5. Cookie Duration

5.1 Affiliate tracking cookies remain valid for 60 days from the date a customer clicks an affiliate link or uses an approved discount code.

5.2 If a customer completes a purchase within the 60-day cookie period, commission will be attributed to the relevant Affiliate.

5.3 If cookies are disabled, cleared, or blocked by the customer, tracking may not occur and commission may not be payable.

6. Personal Purchases & Self-Referrals

6.1 Affiliates may use their own approved discount code for personal purchases and receive the advertised 10% discount.

6.2 Commission is not payable on purchases made by an Affiliate for their own use.

6.3 Any self-referral commissions will be voided and may be cancelled at our discretion.

7. Marketing & Conduct Requirements

7.1 Affiliates must:

- Conduct themselves professionally;
- Promote Legally Healthy in a truthful and accurate manner;
- Comply with all applicable laws, including the Australian Consumer Law;
- Clearly disclose affiliate relationships where required by law.

7.2 Affiliates must not:

- Provide legal advice;
- Represent themselves as Legally Healthy, its employees, agents or contractors;
- Make misleading or false statements about Legally Healthy products;
- Make income guarantees or performance promises;
- Promote products outside their intended jurisdiction.

7.3 Legally Healthy templates are designed for Australian and New Zealand health practitioners and businesses. Affiliates must not actively promote templates to audiences outside Australia and New Zealand.

7.4 Affiliates may promote Legally Healthy's free consultation calls, provided they do not misrepresent the nature of the services offered. Legally Healthy provides legal education and template products only and does not offer custom legal services.

8. Intellectual Property

8.1 All intellectual property in Legally Healthy branding, templates, materials and marketing content remains the property of Legally Healthy.

8.2 Affiliates are granted a limited, revocable, non-exclusive licence to use approved marketing materials solely for the purpose of promoting Legally Healthy under this Program.

9. Dashboard Access & Security

9.1 Affiliates are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of their affiliate dashboard login credentials.

9.2 Affiliates must not share their dashboard access with any third party.

9.3 Any misuse of affiliate access may result in termination from the Program.

10. Privacy

10.1 We collect and handle personal information in accordance with our [Privacy Policy](#) and the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth).

10.2 By participating in the Program, Affiliates consent to the collection and use of their information for affiliate administration purposes.

11. Bonus Incentives

11.1 Legally Healthy may offer discretionary incentives or bonuses from time to time.

11.2 Currently, Affiliates who refer \$3,000 or more in eligible sales within a calendar year may receive a \$25 gift card.

11.3 Bonus programs may be modified or withdrawn at any time.

12. Termination

12.1 Legally Healthy may terminate or suspend an Affiliate's participation at any time, with or without notice.

12.2 Upon termination, the Affiliate must immediately cease using affiliate links, discount codes, and marketing materials.

12.3 Termination does not affect accrued rights to unpaid eligible commissions (subject to these Terms).

13. Independent Contractor Status & Non-Exclusivity

13.1 Affiliates participate in the Program as independent contractors only.

13.2 Nothing in these Terms creates any employment, partnership, agency or joint venture relationship between the parties.

13.3 Participation in the Program is non-exclusive. Affiliates are free to promote other businesses and products, including competitors, provided they comply with these Terms.

14. Limitation of Liability

14.1 To the maximum extent permitted by law, Legally Healthy is not liable for any indirect, consequential or special loss arising from participation in the Program.

14.2 Nothing in these Terms excludes any rights under the Australian Consumer Law.

14. Amendments

We reserve the right to update or modify these Terms at any time. Continued participation in the Program constitutes acceptance of the updated Terms.

15. Governing Law

These Terms are governed by the laws of Western Australia. The parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Western Australia.
